



## WOMEN HAVE A RIGHT TO BE FULLY INFORMED ABOUT THE RISKS OF ABORTION.

Current ACT law requires that women be provided with an informed consent booklet. Wayne Berry's abortion legislation before the Assembly would remove that requirement.

### Doesn't the abortion clinic want me to know?

- I could have excessive blood loss, pelvic infection or incomplete abortion;
- I could have serious complications like perforation of the uterus;
- I could experience serious emotional problems after an abortion;
- Counselling and information about alternatives to abortion are available from agencies other than the abortion clinic;
- Facts about the development of my unborn child.
